TSTA(P) CTA(P) MSc (TA Psychotherapy)

An in-person experiential course taking place on 6 days over 3 weekends. Location: Edinburgh.

Dates: Starts November 2024

#### Overview

This course is for counsellors, psychotherapists and mental health professionals who are looking to integrate body work within their practice and deepen their work with clients or expand the complexity of their therapeutic toolbox.

Somatic work is not limited by modality and integrates a range of theoretical approaches including Transactional Analysis, psychoanalysis, body psychotherapy & trauma-informed work.

The certificate course is for practitioners from any modality who are already in practice and have had some experience of long-term work (i.e. a year) and is suitable for students in advanced training to seasoned practitioners.

Course dates

23 & 24 November 2024 18 & 19 January 2025 5 & 6 April 2025 Somatic TA is a gateway to working with unconscious process and a powerful tool for encouraging change.

Particularly helpful when working with more complex presentations, stuckness, overwhelm anxiety and when other issues in the therapeutic work are difficult to verbalise or access.

The Certificate in Somatic TA is a dynamic and experiential course with plenty of space for play and process. We will practice techniques through group work, observation and supervision to give attendees the confidence to use the somatic within their work.



## **Course Philosophy**

The underpinning philosophical frame of this course is one that considers the bodymind (Dewey, 1925/1981) as central to how we identify and relate and is therefore central to therapeutic change and therapeutic relationship. It sees the somatic as a key gateway to working with unconscious process and a powerful tool for manifesting change.

## Learning outcomes

Learning outcomes from the course include:

- Awareness of your own body process and defences
- Understanding 'bodymind' in the therapeutic relationship and therapeutic interventions.
- Deepening your understanding of unconscious process
- Developing your knowledge of somatic orientated psychotherapy and trauma process
- Developing your own style of working

#### **Course Content**

Module 1: 23 & 24 November 2024
Mapping the Territory - Getting to know your bodymind, establishing contact, space and pace

Content for this module includes:

- Overview of course and group contracting
- Exploring motivations and identifying your learning edges
- Communicating safety in somatic context experimenting with grounding,rhythmic attunement and proxemics
- Unearthing trauma and adverse childhood experiences
- Listening with the body experimenting with script protocol, body armour, social pain
- Understanding the role of somatic process in unconscious process
- Emerging ethical dilemmas
- Skills practice and supervision

Module 2: 18 & 19 January 2025 Expanding the Frame - Moving through new territories, stretching beyond your comfort

Content for this module includes:

- Conceptualising somatic energy through Freudian, Reichen and Transactional Analysis theory
- Reframing stuckness in somatic and theoretical terms
- Deepening contact kinestethic responses, unconscious process and parallel process
- Beyond Ego states revisiting the role of the somatic in mental health
- Linking body structure with personality structure
- Emerging ethical dilemmas
- Observed skills practice and supervision

Module 3: 5 & 6 April 2025
Standing in Your Boots - Developing your own style, taking space and experimenting with flow

Content for this module includes:

- Assessments
- Somatic work in systemic context
- Deepening your understanding of unconscious process
- · Physis and the erotic
- · Exploring resistance to flow
- · Revisiting your edge
- Clarifying what you might need from supervision going forward
- Closure and moving away



#### Assessment

There is one assessment on the course. In the final weekend, you will be asked to deliver a body orientated activity for a client/couple/group (anywhere between 2-10 minutes).

You will be asked to facilitate the exercise with the group followed by facilitating questions and answers about the theoretical underpinnings of your thinking. In addition, there will be an opportunity for group feedback about your activity, facilitation and theory.

Upon successful attendance of all three modules and successful completion of the assessment, you will receive a Certificate in Somatic TA.

#### Course details

The course fees are £850 with a deposit of £200 required to secure your place. Fees can be spread over 3 payments but must be paid in full before the start of the course. \*

Course dates are:

23 & 24 November 2024 18 & 19 January 2025 5 & 6 April 2025

The course times are 10.00am to 5.00pm each day. We provide drinks but you will need to bring a packed lunch. Alternatively, there are cafes nearby where you can purchase food.

Training takes place at EH1 Therapies centre, 4b Randolph Place EH3 7TQ. It is just minutes' walk from Charlotte Square, Princess Street and George Street.
